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AT A GLANCE

About Mississauga

Mississauga is Canada's seventh-largest city with a genuinely diverse housing market: waterfront neighbourhoods, established detached suburbs, and one of the GTA's largest condominium concentrations downtown.

Employment density, Pearson access and the future Hazel McCallion LRT keep both end-user and investor demand active.

KNOWN FOR

What defines Mississauga

- Port Credit - Lakefront village, marina and the city's most walkable pocket.
- Square One & Celebration Square - The downtown core, transit terminal and condo cluster.
- Lakefront Promenade Park - Marina and beach on the east waterfront.
- Erin Mills Town Centre - West-end retail anchor beside Credit Valley Hospital.
- Streetsville - Historic main street with its own village identity.
- Pearson Airport corridor - Employment lands that keep rental demand consistent.

Detached suburbs, executive homes, townhomes and a very large condominium market.

SCHOOLS

Peel District School Board and Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board, plus several independent schools.

Lakefront parks in Port Credit, Erindale Park, Riverwood Conservancy and the Credit River trail system.

MiWay, GO on the Lakeshore West and Milton lines, Highway 401/403/QEW access and the LRT under construction.
